WHILE WE KNOW THAT THE VAST MAJORITY OF CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE ARE SOCIALLY RESPONSIBLE, THERE ARE STILL TOO MANY WHO SPOIL WHERE THEY LIVE BY DAMAGING PROPERTY OR LEAVING LITTER.

CUT TO: TOWN HIGH STREET DAY

OLD MAN PICKS UP CAN AND PLACES IT IN A BIN. YOUNG SCHOOLBOY DOES THE SAME. A YOUNG WOMAN WITH A PRAM STOPS TO PLACE A PLASTIC BAG IN THE BIN.

DAVID STRANG
THE MESSAGE OF THIS CHARMING
STORY STRESSES THE IMPORTANCE OF
TAKING RESPONSIBILITY FOR OUR
ENVIRONMENT.
EVERYONE, HOWEVER YOUNG CAN MAKE

EXT SWAMP NIGERIA DAY

CUT TO: BRANCH OVERHANGING THE POND GIVING CHAZ SOME SHADE. A SWALLOW ALIGHTS ABOVE CHAZ AND SEES HIS SADNESS.

SWALLOW

I COME FROM THE OLD RIVER NITH WHERE THE PEOPLE ARE FRIENDLY DOON HAMERS, WHO LIVE WITH THEIR KIN AND THEIR KITH.

THE CROCODILE STIRS. SEES THE BIRD ABOVE HIM AND LISTENS INTENTLY.

CHAZ

BUT IS THERE A RIVER QUITE WIDE AND QUITE DEEP, WITH PLENTY OF FISH FOR MY SUPPER AND LONG GRASS FOR MY SLEEP?

SWALLOW

THE PEOPLE ARE FRIENDLY BUT THEIR TOWN IS QUITE DIRTY
THEY CALL THEMSELVES DOON HAMERS
AND THEY ALL LIKE TO PARTY
BUT THE RIVER NITH IS WIDE WITH
MUCH FISH
YOU WILL BECOME VERY POPULAR,
THAT IS MY WISH.

CHAZ SMILES AND THINKS. HE LOOKS BACK AT THE FROLICKING CROCODILES IGNORING HIM. HE LOOKS UP AT THE SWALLOW.

EXT CHAZ SWIMS FROM THE RIVER IN NIGERIA TO THE OPEN SEA DAY.

EXT THE ATLANTIC OCEAN DAY

HE PASSES ROUND WEST AFRICA (MAP) THEN SEES FISHING BOATS OFF THE PORTUGUESE COAST.

EXT THE ATLANTIC DAY

HE SWIMS ON AND SEES SPANISH DANCERS ON A CLIFF TOP.

EXT IRISH CHANNEL DAY

THE WATER BECOMES COLDER AND COLDER. (MAP) CHAZ SHIVERS. HE SWIMS UP THE IRISH SEA AND INTO THE SOLWAY ESTUARY (MAP).

EXT SOLWAY COAST DAY

HE ARRIVES AT THE NITH ESTUARY AND SWIMS PAST FIELDS TO THE TOWN OF DUMFRIES.

EXT DUMFRIES DEVORGILLA BRIDGE DAY

HE SETTLES UNDER THE TOWN'S DEVORGILLA BRIDGE. AS HE RESTS, A SMALL BOY, MURRAY AGED 5, ARRIVES AT THE RIVERBANK. MURRAY APPROACHES THE CROCODILE CAREFULLY.

MURRAY

HELLO MY NAME IS MURRAY
I HOPE YOU REALLY WON'T BITE
IF YOU DON'T, THEN I'LL BE YOUR FRIEND
AND I'LL MEET YOU HERE EACH NIGHT.

CHA7

I WAS BORN WITH NO TEETH
YOU'VE NO NEED TO WORRY
SO I ASSURE YOU, YOU'RE SAFE
NOW YOU'RE MY FRIEND, MURRAY.

MURRAY

YOU COULD BE USEFUL TO US AND DO A FEW JOBS LIKE CLEAN THE RIVER OF RUBBISH OF PRAMS AND MOBILES AND KNOBS

CHAZ NODS HIS AGREEMENT

EXT River Nit CENTRE OF TOWN DAY

CHAZ SWIMS INTO THE TOWN CENTRE CLEARING THE RIVERBED OF PRAMS, MOBILES, BICYCLES, SHOPPING TROLLEYS, A CAR NUMBER PLATE, A SKIPPING ROPE AND A FOOTBALL. HE SCOOPS THE ARTICLES ONTO THE RIVERBANK.

EXT RIVER BANK DAY

POLICE COLLECT THE RECOVERED GOODS AND ARE DELIGHTED TO HAND THEM OVER TO HAPPY OWNERS. A POLICEMAN APPROACHES CHAZ AND POINTS TO THE CAUL.

POLICEMAN
OUR WINTER FLOODING IS A PROBLEM
AS YET IT IS UNSOLVED
WHY NOT DREDGE THE RIVER BED?
I'M SURE YOU COULD BE INVOLVED

EXT BELOW THE CAUL ON THE NITH AT DUMFRIES DAY

CHAZ SWIMS OVER THE CAUL AND STARTS TO DREDGE THE RIVERBED ON THE OTHER SIDE. GREAT BURSTS OF BROWN MUD COME UP AND ARE SWEPT DOWN THE RIVER OUT TO SEA.

EXT TOWN CENTRE RIVER BANK DAY

ON THE BANKS, THE TOWN'S COUNCILLORS CHEER AS THEY SEE THEIR FLOODING PROBLEM SOLVED.

EXT TOWN CENTRE AT NIGHT

THE STREETS ARE LITTER SREWN. BOTTLES AND CANS EVERYWHERE AND PATCHES OF DRIED CHEWING GUM SPLATTER THE PAVEMENTS.

## NARRATOR (V/0)

EARLY EVERY MORNING BETWEEN THE HOURS OF TWO AND THREE, CHAZ LEAVES THE RIVER AND THE TOWN HE GOES TO SEE. HIS SHARP CLAWS SCRAPS THE STREETS, CHEWING GUM WILL VANISH AND WITH HIS TAIL HE WIPES AWAY, GRAFFITI WORDS TO BANISH.

CHAZ IS SEEN WALKING DOWN THE HIGH STREET, SCRAPPING CHEWING GUM FROM THE STREET, WIPING GRAFFITI FROM A WALL WITH HIS TAIL AND SCOOPING UP RUBBISH INTO THE BINS.

EXT DEVORGILLA BRIDGE DAY

MURRAY
THE TOWN IS LOOKING MUCH BETTER
BUT THERE'S MUCH MORE THAT YOU
CAN DO
FARMERS UP THE RIVER HAVE SOME
PROBLEMS FOR YOU TOO

EXT UPPER RIVER NITH FARMING LAND DAY

CHAZ SWIMS ALONG THE RIVER

NARRATOR(V/0)
AT LAMING TIME EACH YEAR, FARMERS
COUNT THEIR DWINDLING FLOCKS
EXPOSURE TO RAIN AND FROST CLAIM
SOME, FOR OTHERS, HUNGRY HAWKS.

CHAZ FINDS THREE LAMBS IN THE WATER AND SAFELY RETURNS THEM WITH HIS SNOUT, TO THEW FIELD. HE THEN REPAIRS THE FENCE BY RAISING THE BARBED WIRE.

NARRATOR (CONT'D) SOME HAVE FALLEN INTO THE RIVER GOING THROUGH A FRAGILE FENCE BUT CHAZ SCOOPS UP MANY, THUS SAVING FARMERS PENCE.

EXT UNDER DEVORGILLA BRIDGE DAY

CHAZ LIES ON THE RIVER BANK WATCHING BOYS AND GIRLS ROWING IN COXLESS PAIRS UP AND DOWN THE RIVER. HE IS VERY SAD. TEARS FALL FROM HIS EYES. MURRAY ARRIVES TO SEE HIM UPSET.

CHA7

AT LAST I FEAR, I KNOW MY TEETH INDEED ARE NOW GROWING.
THIS PUTS AT RISK THE BOYS AND GIRLS WHO USE THE NITH FOR ROWING.

MURRAY

THEN HOME IS WHERE YOU NOW SHOULD GO TO SPEND YOUR FUTURE DAYS.
BUT THANKS TO YOU DEAR CHAZ,
WE'VE LEARNED TO MEND OUR WAYS.

EXT NIGERIAN SWAMP DAY

NARRATOR (V/O) CHAZ RETURNS AT LAST TO THE NIGER AND HE'S HAPPY TO GREET ALL HE MEETS HE SPEAKS OF HIS TIME IN COLD SCOTLAND AND THE DAYS HE CLEANED UP THE STREETS.

THERE IS MUCH HAPPINESS BACK AT THE SWAMP AS THEY SEE CHAZ RETURN FROM HIS TRAVELS AND HE IS MADE THE CENTRE OF THEIR ATTENTION IN THEIR NATIVE POND.

EXT DUMFRIES TOWN CENTRE DAY

MURRAY IS STANDING BEFORE A LARGE NUMBER OF PUPILS FROM THE LOCAL PRIMARY SCHOOL, PARENTS, TEACHERS AND POLICEMEN.

MURRAY

THIS TALE IS MORE THAN A STORY
IT'S A LESSON TO LEARN THIS DAY
KEEP YOUR TOWN AND RIVERBEDS TIDY
IT'S GOOD THAT THEY LOOK THIS WAY.

THE CROWD CHEER.

MURRAY CONT'D (CLOSE ON)

FOR IF YOU DON'T, REMEMBER
THEN GUESS WHAT YOU WILL FIND? PAUSE.
A CROC WITH LONG SHARP TEETH WILL HAVE YOUR

CHAZ CLOSE UP

A FULL FRONT SHOT OF CHAZ. CHAZ THEN OPENS HIS MOUTH REVEALING ROWS OF SHARP WHITE TEETH AND A BRIGHT RED TONGUE. HE OPENS HIS MOUTH WIDE. HE CLOSES HIS MOUTH WITH A LOUD CRUNCH. THERE IS A SCREAM OF A CHILD.

INT EDUCATION HEAD OFFICES EDINBURGH RD DUMFRIES

WE SEE THE DOOR PLATE OF THE DIRECTOR FOR EDUCATION, THE DOOR OPENS. MR FRASER SANDERSON IS AT HIS DESK.

FRASER SANDERSON
WE ALL RECOGNISE THE CONCERNS
WHICH SOCIETY IN GENERAL HOLDS
ABOUT ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOR IN ITS
VARIOUS FORMS - VANDALISM,
LITTER, EXCESSIVE NOISE,
INTIMIDATING BEHAVIOUR. WE ALSO
APPRECIATE THE NEED TO INSTILL IN
